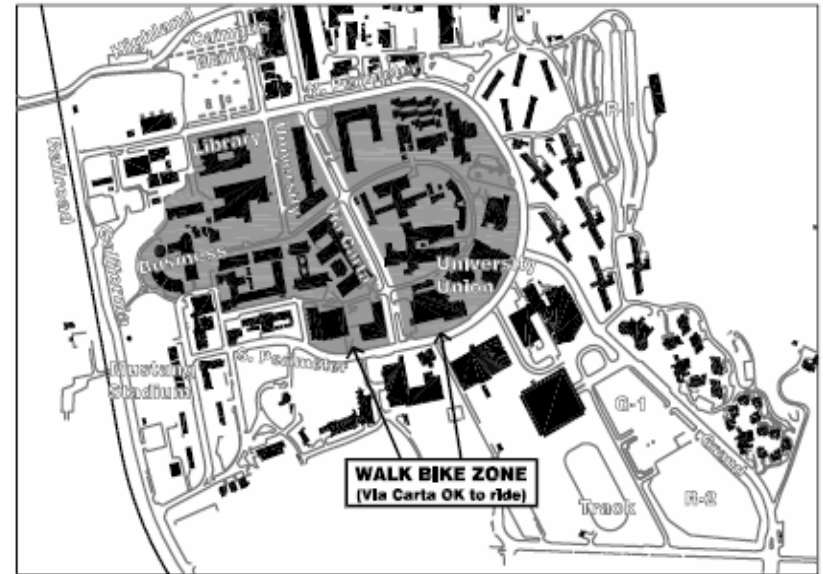
Bicycle Safety Regulations

Keep in mind: The bicycle is a vehicle.

Every person riding a bicycle on a roadway has all rights and is subject to all the provisions applicable to the driver of any other vehicle. Riders must obey all traffic regulations, speed limits, and stop signs. These regulations are described in California Vehicle Code 21200 and are applicable on campus.

Rules to Know:

1. Bicyclists are required to utilize the bike lane where available. (21208 VC)
2. Bicyclists must stop at all stop signs. (22450(a) VC)
3. Bicyclists must ride in the same direction as traffic. (21650.1 VC)
4. Bicyclists must always have at least one ear uncovered (i.e. headsets). (27400 VC)
5. Every bicycle operated on a highway during darkness shall be equipped with a lamp emitting a white light and reflector. (21201d VC)
6. When left unattended, all bicycles must be locked in designated bike racks. (20.4 CPSU)
7. Campus residents are required to register their bicycle with the University Police. There is no charge for this service. (20.6 CPSU)
8. Violations may be recorded on your driver's license record.



20.2 CPSU Bicycle Prohibition/Outdoors – Bicycle riding is prohibited in the following areas:

- On any portion of the Poly View Drive This is a Walk Your Bike Zone, violators are subject to citation.
- On sidewalks.
- Outside of bicycle lanes where bicycle lanes are provided.
